# Moody's upgrades the rating for SCHMOLZ + BICKENBACH

- Moody's upgrades the rating to B2 with a stable outlook
- The rating agency recognises efficiency gains and reduction of debt
- Rating upgrade acknowledges new course of SCHMOLZ + BICKENBACH

Emmenbrücke, 24 November 2014 – Today, Moody's has upgraded the rating for SCHMOLZ + BICKENBACH AG, a global market leader in special steel (such as tool steel, stainless steel, and engineering steel) listed on the SIX Swiss Exchange (SIX: STLN). After the previous rating of B3 the upgrade by one full notch is an acknowledgement of the new course of SCHMOLZ + BICKENBACH. The outlook is stable.

Moody's justifies its rating upgrade with the enhanced profitability of the Company and the improved cash flow generation. The rating agency recognises the efficiency gains, rationalisation as well as the restructuring of business units. Moreover, debt has been reduced significantly following the capital increase in October 2013. Moody's expects that SCHMOLZ + BICKENBACH's profitability will continue to improve and will translate into positive free cash flow in 2014 and 2015. Furthermore debt is expected to be further reduced.
